1. The school will follow the national syllabus for the middle classes.
2. The school must submit its information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per the Board's Circular No:CBSE/Aff./4/Circular/2016, dated 10.11.2016, within 30 days from the receipt of this grant letter. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website:www.cbse.nic.in.
3. The School has been granted regular Affiliation with the Board w.e.f. 01.04.2019 onwards. Accordingly, the School is eligible to start class IX from the academic session 2019-20 and 1st batch of class X of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in the year 2021.
4. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
5. The school shall appoint only qualified and eligible staff.
6. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instruction issued thereon by the CBSE /Respective State Govt./UT Govt. from time to time.
7. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required.
8. The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required.
9. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
10. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
11. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed or May be prescribed by the Board from time to time.
12. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
